

 - Authentication library

- Authorization notwithstanding
 - WAC vs ACP vs "dialects"
 - SAI is *still* a draft
 - Just keep everything private!

 - Catch all exceptions
 - Ignore individual document errors (malformed, permissions, etc.)
 - Keeplogs



- Fail gracefully
- Facilitate reporting
 - Provide context: request url, response, etc.
 - Not everyone is a developer.
 - Not everyone is on a desktop device.


Something went wrong, but it's not your fault. Try again! Vie

View details

- Fail gracefully
- Facilitate reporting
- Beware of destructive operations
 - There will be bugs, better safe than sorry
 - It's better to duplicate data than deleting or overriding
 - PATCH instead of PUT





I'm <u>working</u> on a pantry app. I want to use recipes compatible with <u>Umai</u>, but connected with a record of what ingredients are in the house. I have a more or less functional version that I've started using in my home. It's rough around the edges and I keep thinking of new functionality that would improve its usability. But that's a key part of why I've built it the way I have - the idea of enabling user control over both their data and the interfaces used to interact with it.
